

FACTS**WHAT DOES AMERICAN WEB LOAN DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and identifying information (name, address, email, phone, IP address) ■ Employment history and financial data, bank account/routing, credit and debit information ■ Geolocation data and government issued identification
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons we choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?

This privacy notice is provided by AWL, Inc. d/b/a American Web Loan.

What we do

How does American Web Loan protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does American Web Loan collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- submit a loan application or share contact or account information
- provide financial information or information regarding employment
- set up payments through the myaccount portal or mobile app

We also collect your personal information from credit bureaus, financial companies, service providers and other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more information.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Our affiliates include entities wholly-owned by the Otoe-Missouria Tribe of Indians, a federally recognized Indian Tribe.

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Nonaffiliates with which we share personal information include service providers and direct marketing companies for application resell, direct mail and other purposes.

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- Our joint marketing partners can include financial services companies and organizations with which we have agreements to jointly market financial products

Other important information

California: The California Consumer Act of 2018 grants certain rights to California residents pertaining to personal data that a company may collect from them. These provisions do not apply to personal data processed by financial institutions under federal law like the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act.

Tribal Notice: AWL is an arm of the Otoe-Missouria Tribe of Indians, and is licensed and regulated by the Tribe's Consumer Finance Services Regulatory Commission pursuant to the Tribe's Consumer Financial Services Ordinance. AWL does not sell personal identifying information to any third parties except as may be required for debt collection.
